### Recipes from Pasta Power, Jr. 4-H Chef Contest Otsego County Fair

### Strawberry Chicken Pasta Salad

### For Salad

3-4 cups of cooked pasta 6-8-oz cooked chicken

1-3 cups of your favorite cold vegetables

1 cup fresh strawberries

Desired nuts or seeds

### For Dressing

16-oz frozen strawberries (thawed)

6 Tbsp. lemon juice

1/4 cup Sugar

2 Tbsp. cider vinegar

2 Tbsp. Oil



### **Directions**

In a large bowl, toss the salad ingredients together.

Process frozen strawberries in a blender until pureed.

Add lemon juice and sugar to pureed mixture. Blend well.

Add in cider vinegar and oil while blending fruit.

Pour dressing over pasta to coat completely.

### Notes

The dressing recipe makers 2 1/2 cups, so you may want to use discretion and smaller portions of the dressing to suit your taste. Keep leftovers in the refrigerator

### **Tomato Pesto Pasta Salad**

### **Ingredients**

4 1/8 cups Greek yogurt

3/4 cup water

2 Large tomatoes diced

2 lbs. of cooked Fusilli pasta

2 Cups homemade pesto

8 oz. mozzarella cheese

### For Pesto

2 cups basil

3/4 cup Parmesan cheese

1/2 Cup Sunflower seeds

3/4 cup Olive oil

3 cloves of garlic

1 Tsp. salt

1 Tbsp. honey

### Macaroni Salad

### **Ingredients:**

1lb macaroni mayonnaise (to taste) 1/8 cup onion

2 cups cucumber

2 stalks celery

2 cups tomatoes

1/4 cup peeled carrots



### Spices:

A pinch of Celery Salt, Onion and Garlic Powder, Parsley, Salt and Pepper
