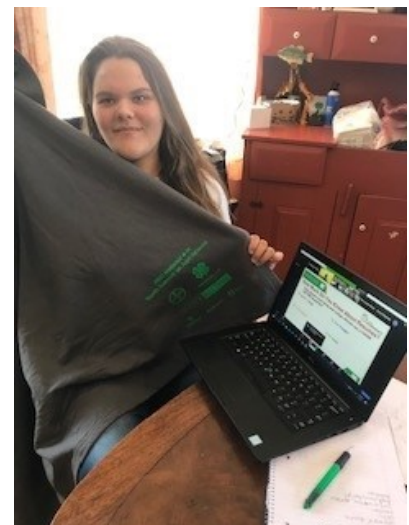

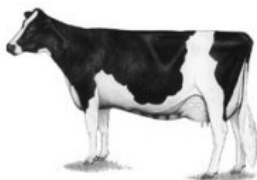

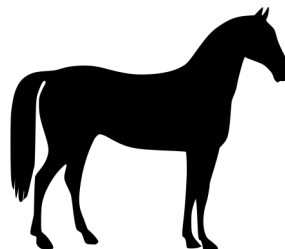


This workshop will provide the 4-H dairy exhibitor how to show your animal to its best advantage as well as appearance of the exhibitor and equipment and appearance of the animal.

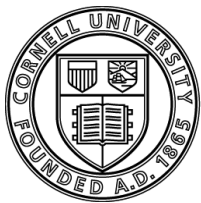
