#### The program

The 4-H Earn-An-Animal program allows for Otsego County youth ages 8-18(as of January 1) to earn funding towards a project animal to raise and show as their own. This program requires dedication from the youth member and support from their guardians. Youth accepted to the program will not only learn how to care for their animal, they will experience the process of researching, selecting and purchasing an animal. Through the 4-H Earn-An-Animal Project, 4-H youth will further develop their planning, time management, organization, and record keeping skills.


A key for succeeding in this world is being able to have your voice heard.

Livestock Auction species include: beef, goats, poultry, rabbits, sheep and swine. Requirements of the program will be explained. Youth MUST be accompanied by at least one parent/guardian during the meeting.

#### **About the Program**

The 4-H Livestock Market Program teaches sustainable animal husbandry practices that produce healthy livestock for our local meat market. From start to finish, these youth learn all aspects of the market process including animal nutrition, evaluation and selection, welfare, marketing, and processing.
